

AUSTRALIAN MUZZLE LOADING CHAMPIONSHIPS

The NSWMLA is pleased to advise that the 62nd Australian Muzzle Loading Championships will go ahead this Easter thanks to Kelvin Muzzle Loading Pioneers.

Due to various constraints, the format of the Championships will be different to that traditionally held. Firstly, the Championships will be held in two parts at two different locations.

All short-range events; (100 yd rifle, musket, cannon and shotgun) will be held at Marlow Range near Gunnedah.

The long-range rifle events;(300 and 500 yd events) will be held at Hill End later in the year.

We realize that this is very short notice, but we urge anyone who would normally attend the event at Hill End to support this shoot.

For those interested in attending. The event is being Hosted by Kelvin Muzzle Loading Pioneers, an NSWMLA member Club. Marlow Range has plenty of level parking for caravans and shaded areas for general camping. There are two hot showers and three flushing toilets. The range is some 20 km from Gunnedah,

Directions to the range. From Gunnedah, travel east over the Namoi River bridge for approx. 3 kms, turn right onto Orange Grove Road. There is approximately 6 kms of tar and 6 kms of good gravel road until you reach a set of galvanised cattle yards on your right. Immediately on your left is a property sign for Marlow. Go through the gate and follow the track to the next gate, immediately turn right and follow the track into the range. All camping must be below the Club house. Camping fees explained at Registration.
